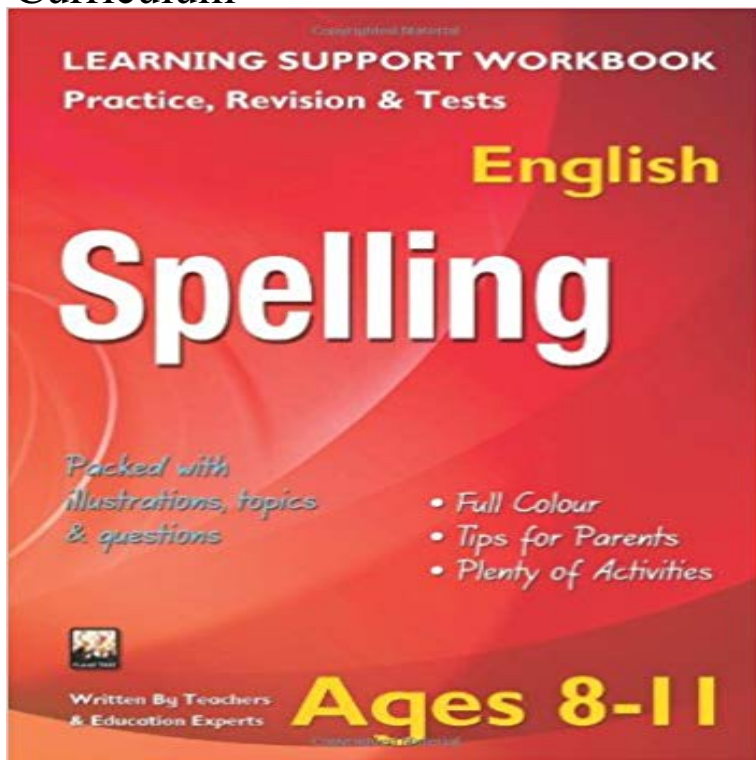


Spelling, Ages 8-11 (English): Home Learning, Support for the Curriculum
