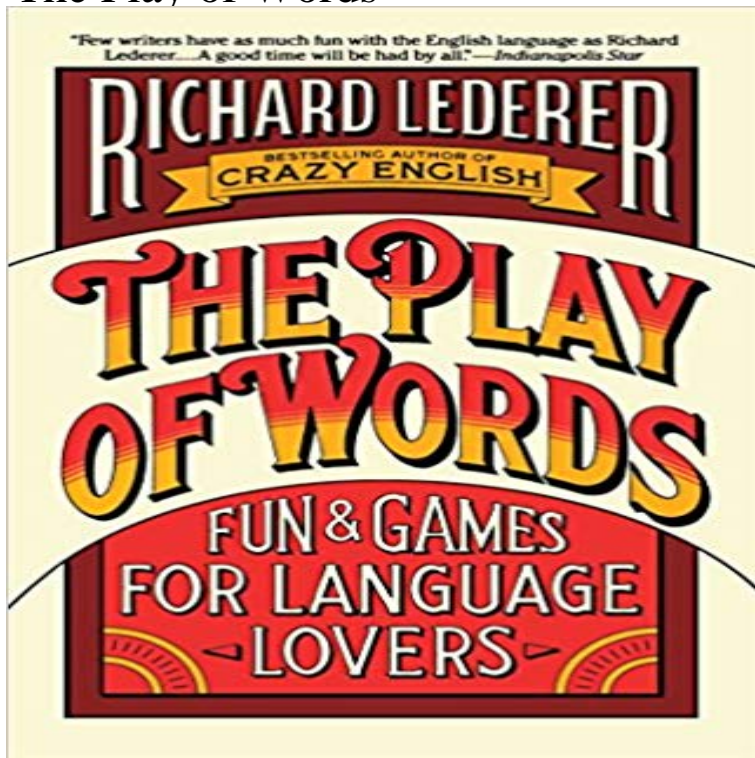


The Play of Words
